


Candy Monster



A group of square-eyed children were moving some large square bricks. Henry approached them and asked, "Is this a game?"




After making strenuous efforts to move them to the south side of the castle, Henry was already sweating all over and wanted to take a break. He took out the mobile phone and shouted when playing with it.
